## LEARNING GOALS

This is a comprehensive course in the basics of modern dog training - "nose to tail" coverage from the basics of learning theory to practical application and problem solving.

## Upon completing the course, you will be able to:

- 1. Use three key techniques to begin simple and complex behavior: capturing, targeting, and shaping
- 2. Train reliable behavior with a marker and reinforcers, without the need for corrections or physical control
- 3. Teach new behaviors by breaking them down into small, achievable pieces
- 4. Identify and choose approaches for addressing problem behavior
- 5. Replace undesired behaviors with the behaviors you want
- 6. Select, add and strengthen appropriate cues to any behavior
- 7. Interpret dogs' emotional states through their body language
- 8. Fit training skills into daily life with dogs
- 9. Identify the key stages of canine development
- 10. Describe what socialization is, why it is important, and how to use clicker training to help build your dog's confidence
- 11. Describe what marker-based (clicker) training is and why it works faster and better than punishment-based or control-based training techniques
- 12. Create training plans to teach new behaviors quickly and easily and help ensure your dog's success
- 13. Practice "clean" training techniques, such as holding the clicker properly, keeping body language still, and delivering food treats swiftly and accurately
- 14. Identify and use "real-life" reinforcement opportunities
- 15. Understand the difference between management and training, and know how and when to use each



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- 16. Understand the fall-out and pitfalls of punishment as training technique
- 17. Critically evaluate and "debunk" some popular myths about dog training
- 18. Self assess and improve your training skills
- 19. Gain a basic understanding of the four quadrants of operant conditioning and where clicker training fits in
- 20. Make veterinary and grooming visits more fun using clickertrained behaviors
